ADDITIONAL FIRE TABLES & BOWLS INFORMATION

Introduction: For thousands of years, fire has been a focal point for communal gatherings, celebrations and feasts. Today we employ fire for more than just heating and cooking, we gather with friends and family around fire pits in a convivial atmosphere of warmth and good cheer. Stone Yard's unique and distinctive collection of handcrafted fire tables and bowls will enhance your outdoor living and entertainment design projects, providing ambient lighting and heat as well as surface areas suitable for drinks, appetizers and light meals.

Finding the ideal size: When researching fire tables or fire bowls, first consider the purpose and the overall environment where it will be used. Take into account the amount of space needed, along with the seating and tables. Will the fire table or bowl need to have enough surface for cocktails and hors d'oeuvres, or will it only be used primarily for heat and ambience? Compare the heights of the fire table or bowl in relation to the surrounding seating, to make sure it's all cohesive.

Material: Stone Yard's luxury fire tables and bowls are constructed of GFRC (glass fiber reinforced concrete) which offers a natural stone-like appearance, but is lighter in weight, hand-constructed and comes in a variety of artisanal finishes.

WHAT TYPE OF FUEL IS BEST?

Propane: Propane is readily available almost everywhere, and conveniently comes in exchangeable or refillable tanks. Using propane tanks make it easy to move your fire table or bowl to a new location. However, keep in mind that while propane makes these fire units more flexible, replenishing propane or running out in the middle of an event or gathering can put a damper on things.

Natural Gas: Connecting your fire table or bowl to natural gas is convenient for homeowners who spend a great deal of time outdoors, and want to permanently connect the fire unit to a fuel source that will never run dry. This requires professional installation of a gas line from your home, and most likely means the fire unit will stay in the location where it is installed, offering no flexibility.

Bio-Ethanol: Ethanol is an eco-friendly and readily available renewable energy source that's clean burning and produces no smoke. As with propane, Bio-Ethanol is stored in portable containers, allowing for greater flexibility as far as placement of the fire table or bowl. However, while providing a realistic flame that's consistent and reliable, Bio-Ethanol does not produce as much heat as propane or natural gas.

KEEP IN MIND

It's important to ensure your fire table or bowl is sufficiently secured and placed on a stable surface. Don't forget to regularly clean it, removing any debris or ash. Also, to maintain the quality and look of your Stone Yard fire table or bowl for years to come, consider a water-resistant cover for when it's not in use.
